

Step-by-Step guidelines for your journey towards getting the driving license

Step 1: Step 1: EDI Registration & RTA File Opening

 ${\sf EDI}$ branches or website - www.edi.ae - by submitting all required documents and making course payment.

Step 2: Lectures (Online / Offline)

Attend 8 mandatory lectures:

*Online – Go to **www.edi.ae**, student login tab and then click on e-Lectures. Lectures are available in English and Urdu. *LIVE lectures can be attended in English, Urdu and Arabic, as per lecture schedule. We also provide exclusive 'Ladies only' lectures at building No. 12, Al Qusais. You must carry the RTA Book, Learning Permit, Emirates ID and the MDT Card to attend the lectures and the practical training. If the MDT card was not given during registration, please arrive 30 mins prior the lecture at any of the 3 main centers to collect the MDT card from information desk.

Step 3: Book and Attend RTA Theory Test

Please note that you must pass your theory test before starting the practical training. The test can only be taken at the Testing Center you have registered in or at which your registration branch comes under.

Book Theory Test	Booking can be done through EDI main centers, branches or EDI Call Center (04-263 1100). Test can be taken between 08:00 am - 04:15 pm from Saturday to Thursday. For students who have difficulty in attending the RTA theory test in 3 available languages, which are Arabic, English or Hindi/Urdu, there is Remote Interpretation Service (RIS), which is an instant Theory Test translation service available in different languages. As per RTA guidelines, students have to submit an application for appointing an interpreter in the preferred language at the time of opening RTA file and pay the applicable fees. Kindly note RIS familiarization course is provided at AI Qusais, which a student must attend before attending the RTA Theory test with RIS service.
Practice Theory Test	 Booking and attending EDI Mock test available at 3 main centers (Book via call center) Book and attend Theory Test Preparation Lecture* Download RTA Mobile App called "RTA Dubai," and practice theory test under drivers' licensing section Thoroughly read and practice the questions provided in the RTA handbook
Attend theory Test	Please report 30 mins at the test location before the scheduled time. If you pass, proceed to your next step. In case you fail, re-book the test and take it again.
* Theory Test Preparation Lecture (TTPL) is available at 3 centers, in three languages (Arabic, English and Urdu) for students who are having difficulty in passing theory test. Please check	

the TTPL schedule or call 04-263 1100.

Step 4: Simulator Class

Book your simulator training by calling EDI Call center (04-2631100) or by visiting the 3 main EDI testing centres. Class is available on all weekdays (except Friday) between 8:30 am – 05:30 pm.

Step 5: Practical Training

Book and take your practical training, as per the course opted at the time of registration. Book your training by visiting the branch, main centre or calling the call centre. On your first day of training please meet the scheduling staff to collect your training sheet and then proceed towards the training vehicle. You can avail our free bus transport service available at 3 centres.

Note: A male student will take 14 hours; (remaining 6 hours will be dedicated for Night, Independent and Highway driving) whereas a female student will take 16 hours (remaining 4 hours will be dedicated for Independent and Highway driving) during this stage. Your instructor may extend your training further, if he/she does not finds you to be fit for RTA Testing.

Step 6: Attend Night Training

Once you have been well trained on all stages of Road and the 5 parking maneuver and when your instructor feels that you're ready to attend the assessment test on road, he recommends your name for Night class booking. A male student is required to book and attend 2 hours of night classes (8 pm to 11 pm). For female students, the classes are optional by RTA. You may book the classes at your branch or the 3 main centres or by calling our call centre.

Important Information:

- Please bring your RTA learner's permit, EDI student card (MDT), Emirates ID and RTA driving handbook for every training class, lecture and driving test.
- In case you need to change any test date, please provide 2-3 working days' notice through call center or by mailing us at info@edi.ae
- In case you wish to stop training at any point, you can do so through EDI call center / EDI staff at training locations (48 hours prior notice is required). To start your training again, inform the call center / EDI scheduling staff.
- If you do not attend any of the scheduled training class, you will be marked absent and will have to pay and attend for that absent class.

Step 7: Assessment Test (Internal Test by EDI's Assessors)

After completing night training (mandatory training for male students and optional for female students) and having cleared all your pending amount book your Road Assessment Test through EDI call centre at 3 main centres and attend the road assessment test on the booked date.

The test is available on all working days for Weekday course registered students and on Friday for Friday and Weekend course registered students. In any case the test will be conducted at your testing centre.

Once you have passed the Road assessment test , please proceed to the next step. In case you fail in the road assessment test, you will have to take 4 hours of practical training followed by re-assessment test. Our Assessors may recommend extra hours apart from mandatory 4 hours based on your performance during the test and number of mistakes you have made. You can pay and book for the mandatory hours and re-assessment test via EDI call centres / or your scheduling staff.

All male and female students are recommended to attend the Solo Driving Class for 1 hour available at Al Qusais main centre between 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. EDI has a Solo Training Yard for learners to drive unaccompanied wherein the whole solo driving session is closely monitored and remotely managed by dedicated EDI staff at all times.

Step 8: Assessment test in the Smart Yard

Once you have passed the Road assessment test, you are eligible for the booking of Yard assessment test in the Smart Yard.Please arrive 30 mins prior to your scheduled test time in the Smart Yard at the assigned test centre and submit your learning permit to the test coordinator. You will be tested on all 5 maneuvers on the same day, which you need to pass to move to the next step. In case you fail in any of the parking maneuver, you must pay and attend 1 hour of practical training before booking & appearing for only the failed parking maneuver. For any clarification, please contact the test department or call EDI call centre.

Step 9: RTA Parking Test - Garage, Parallel, 60 degree, Hill and Emergency stop. Available at 3 main centres

Once you have passed the yard assessment test in the smart yard, you are eligible for the RTA parking test in the smart yard. Please arrive 30 mins prior to your scheduled test time at the assigned test centre and submit your learning permit to the test coordinator. You will be tested in the smart yard on all 5 maneuvers on the same day, which you need to pass to move to the next step. In case you fail in any of the parking maneuver, you must pay and attend 1 hour of practical training before booking & appearing for only the failed parking maneuver. For any clarification, please contact the test department or call EDI call centre.

Step 10: Book and attend Independent and Highway Training (4 hours training)

After passing your RTA parking test ,please book and attend 4 hours of Independent and Highway practical training (2 hours each).

Independent Driving means that the student will be asked to drive to a particular destination/route, which they will have to follow without any intervention from the instructor. Four route maps will be provided to each student by the instructor. During these 2 hours, the student will be trained how to drive independently on each route.

Step 11: Book RTA Road Test

After attending Independent and Highway training you are eligible to book your Final RTA Road Test. To book this test you can either call the RTA Call Center @ 800 9090 or use the RTA Smart Self-Booking Screens available in Test Department of our 3 main centers. The test can be taken on weekdays i.e. Sunday to Thursday between 07:30 am - 03:25 pm. Extra charge applies for booking Saturday Road Test.

Step 12: Attend the RTA Road Test at your Main Center

Please report at least 30 minutes before your scheduled test time at the assigned test center. If you pass the RTA Road Test, please collect the clearance certificate from EDI cashier and then proceed to collect your Driving License from the test department. **DRIVE SAFELY!** In case you fail the RTA Road Test, please pay, book and attend mandatory 4 hours for training and then book for the Road Test again.
